- 3.1. Calendar – 8 weeks beginning Jan 8
- 3.2. Split divisions based on: 2011 record, 2011 DIAA playoffs, and individual team ratings
- 3.3. Playoffs – 2 weeks at end of season; all teams qualify
 - 3.3.1. Inclement weather will result in a reduced playoff format
 - 3.3.2. Goal is to have all teams play a minimum of eight games
- 3.4. Full schedule will be released by Wed, Jan 11

4. General Information

- 4.1. Each team must pay \$14 to the umpire before each game

- 4.1.1. Any team that forfeits will be billed the full officials' fee plus a \$5 administrative fee
 - 4.1.2. Team not at fault does not pay the officials
 - 4.1.3. Games can be cancelled in advance by calling the Sports Office by 4:00 pm on Thursday – no forfeit fee is charged
 - 4.2. Fully equipped goaltender is required
 - 4.2.1. All equipment must be clean and free of dirt and dried mud, which makes the floors very slippery
 - 4.3. Arrive 20 minutes early in order to take the court as soon as possible and start your game on time – there are continuous games scheduled from 2:00 till 9:00 pm
 - 4.4. Inclement weather message line: 302-395-5891
 - 4.4.1. Call if weather is questionable
 - 4.4.2. We don't want the girls driving if the weather is questionable so our policy is to err on the side of caution and cancel when appropriate
 - 4.5. Player Participation Forms must be signed by a parent and in the possession the team manager before any player may participate
 - 4.5.1. Rosters and waivers are due to the league coordinator at the end of Week 2
 - 4.6. There must be an adult in charge of the team bench at all times
 - 4.7. There is no protected seating in the gym – spectators must use caution and not sit in the vicinity of the goals
 - 4.8. Completed line-up cards, which should include only the players present for that game, should be submitted to the official before the game
