Due to a serious incident at the conclusion of the Pizza By Elizabeth vs U Peru match on Thursday, June 2, the following actions are in effect:

1. Pizza By Elizabeth games for June 7th and 9th are cancelled.
2. U Peru games for June 7th and 9th are cancelled.
3. Managers only (no assistants or other players) from both teams must attend a meeting with the Sports Administrator and League Coordinator at 5:00pm, Wednesday, June 8 at the Sports Office.
4. Managers must bring to the meeting complete rosters with player names, uniform numbers, phone numbers, and addresses. Signatures are not required at this time.
5. Managers must be prepared to identify all players involved in the post-game incident. Withholding information or providing inaccurate information will result in the removal of the team from the program.
6. Managers may bring written statements from any person wishing to provide comments on this incident.
7. Further sanctions will be issued after the meeting on Wednesday.

Note to all teams

Zero tolerance for unsportsmanlike conduct, especially at youth soccer facilities, is discussed at every manager's meeting. There should be no doubt in anyone's mind of the intent of this office to aggressively deter such behavior. *Violators will be removed from the program without additional warnings, and teams with patterns of poor behavior will be removed from future participation with no refund of fees.*

NOTE: Players are not permitted to be at their team's playing sites while serving suspensions. Team members are not permitted to dispute league actions with staff or officials. Repeat offenses by the same individual will result in additional penalties.
