1. I have received a written complaint from the management of Hockessin Soccer Club about three separate incidences that occurred last Sunday. Briefly, they are:

- Drinking in the parking lot at 9:40 at night. When asked to leave, those persons involved became verbally abusive to the Hockessin staff member. This incident is attributed to persons affiliated with the Tury's Drywall team.
- A player from Tenancingo took a ball away from a child. When the child's mother confronted the player, he returned the ball and eventually apologized after finding the ball he was looking for.
- The third incident involved a child verbally abusing another child with ethnic slurs.

The incidences described above speak for themselves and do not need further elaboration. Effective immediately, the following policies are in effect with no further warning:

- Before each game, teams should warn their spectators about the league's zero tolerance for alcohol and unsportsmanlike conduct at the game sites and the penalties that will occur if anyone violates this policy.
- Any person observed with alcohol in their presence will cause the police to be called with the intent of having that person arrested for possession of alcohol.
 - If that person is a player, manager, or coach observed with alcohol in their presence before, during, or after any game, the team will be immediately removed from the league.
 - If that person is a spectator, the game will be immediately terminated and a forfeit declared against the offending team. This team will not be permitted to have any spectators in future games and will be considered for removal from the program.
- Any incident of unsportsmanlike conduct (spectator or team member) will cause the violator to be removed from the site for the remainder of the season and the team will be considered for removal from the program.
- A New Castle County staff member will be closely monitoring the spectator and parking lot areas for offenders.

Please remember that teams are responsible for the actions of spectators who come to watch their games.

Everyone should be aware that New Castle County is a guest at this facility and will not jeopardize our good standing with the Hockessin Soccer Club. We will aggressively pursue any violator and the team they are affiliated with and promptly remove them for further participation in our programs.

NOTE: Managers are required to call their opponents to confirm rescheduled games. Games not played due to lack of notification of a team may not be rescheduled.

2. All games will be played at the Hockessin Soccer Club. The follow games have been rescheduled:
