Forfeits (due to insufficient players to start a game) will be paid by New Castle County and the offending team will be billed for the full officials' fee plus an administrative fee.

Line-up Cards and Uniform Requirements - Teams are required to submit line-up cards before each game with a legible listing of players' first and last names and jersey numbers. Players who do not meet the uniform requirements by June 21 will not be permitted to play.

Reporting Game Results / Standings - The winning team (or home team if the score is tied) must report the game results to the league coordinator each night. The penalty for not reporting game scores is the loss of points for that game. Results should appear in the News Journal 1-2 days after the game is played; updated standings are posted on the Sports and Athletics website on Friday mornings and published in the Sunday News Journal.

Kirkwood Soccer Club / Montessori School / Hockessin Soccer Club– Rules and Regulations

- Park only in designated spaces, not in unmarked areas or in the grass
