INCOME GUIDELINES
Effective April 01, 2018**

Listed below are the current income guidelines for use for the various funding sources.

Families larger than eight persons, compute the income as follows:

For each person in excess of eight, 8.00 percent for the four-person base should be added to the eight person income limits. All limits should be rounded to the nearest \$50.
