DIVISIONS/CLASSES:

Leadline – Open to all riders who cannot ride on their own. All riders will be on-line.

1. Walk
2. Walk/Trot
3. Trot Over 4 Poles

Walk/ Trot – For riders in their 1st year of showing. Riders may not enter into a canter class at this show.

4. Walk
5. Walk/Trot on your own
6. Walk/Trot as a group

Walk/Trot/Canter – Open to riders who are not jumping at this show.

7. Walk/Trot
8. Walk/Trot/Canter on your own
9. Walk/Trot/ Canter as a group

Beginner Equitation – Open to riders in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. Riders will not be penalized for trotting fences.

11. Walk/Trot/Canter
12. 2' cross rails

****Schooling Break****

Horse & Rider Combo – Open to horse/rider combinations not jumping over 2' at this show. Riders are judged 50% on mount, 50% on rider.

13. Walk/ Trot
14. Walk/Trot/Canter
15. Over Fences – Choice 2' cross rails or 2'

Baby Green Horse/Pony – Open to horses or ponies in their 1st or 2nd year of showing. No penalty for trotting fences.

16. Walk/ Trot
17. Walk/Trot/Canter
18. Over Fences – Choice 2' cross rails or 2'

Pleasure Horse/Pony

19. Walk/Trot
20. Walk/Trot/Canter
21. Over Fences 2'

Hunter Horse/Pony

22. Walk/Trot
23. Walk/Trot/Canter
24. Over Fences – choice of 2' or 2'6" or 3'

Open Equitation

25. Walk/Trot
26. Walk/Trot/Canter
27. Over Fences 2'6" or 3'

HORSE SHOW RULES:

1. Classes may be divided, combined, canceled, or re-ordered if conditions warrant.
2. Western riders may enter English classes.
3. A rider's age is the age as of January 1, 2019.
4. When mounted, all riders must wear boots with a ½" heel and ASTM/SEI certified helmets with harnesses. Dress code is show attire or polo and breeches. Half chaps are acceptable.
5. Judges decisions are final.
6. All dogs must be leashed (although we would prefer that they stay home).
7. Fence heights are approximate.
8. A negative Coggins test (within 1 year) is required.
9. Schooling will be held from 7:30 - 8:45 AM and where permitted in the schedule. The show starts promptly at 9 AM.
10. New Castle County, Carousel Park, and show management are not responsible for any damage, injury, or loss to persons, animals, or property of any exhibitor or spectator on or off the show grounds.
11. Points are awarded 6-5-4-3-2-1, each class will be awarded 6 ribbons and there will be a division Champion and Reserve Champion awarded.
