Maryann gets us started making our quilt with an introduction to the Log Cabin Square.

Materials used in this episode:

- Electronic sewing machine
- Thread (cotton or polyester, cotton recommended)
- Bobbin
- ¼-inch seam foot (for quilting)
- Scissors just quilting
- Clips
- 45mm Rotary Cutter (60mm for heavy fabrics)
- Fiskars Rotary Blade 45mm Titanium
- Quilting Ruler
- OLFA Rotating Cutting Matt
- Iron
- Ironing Matt
- Seam Ripper

Fabric for this project:

Cotton material needed the quilt will have a light half and a dark half use a color of your choice.

Precut fabric to make your squares:

- Center square 3 ½"
- Cut in to strips the following
- One 2" x 3 ½"
- Two 2" x 5"
- Two 2" x 6 ½"
- Two 2" x 8"
- Two 2" x 9 ½"
- Two 2" x 10 ½"
- One 2" x 12"
